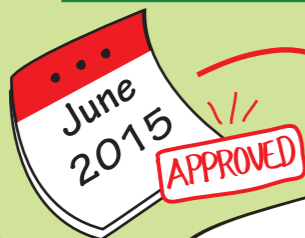

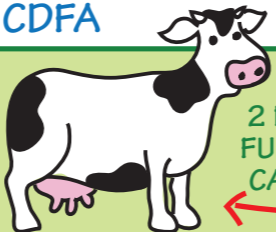


Focus on implementation

\$ 11.1m to milk producers & dairy digester development

PHASE 2
\$ 500,000 to investigate research gaps

★ ICAO will lay the foundation for UNFCCC since they're 2-4 years ahead.

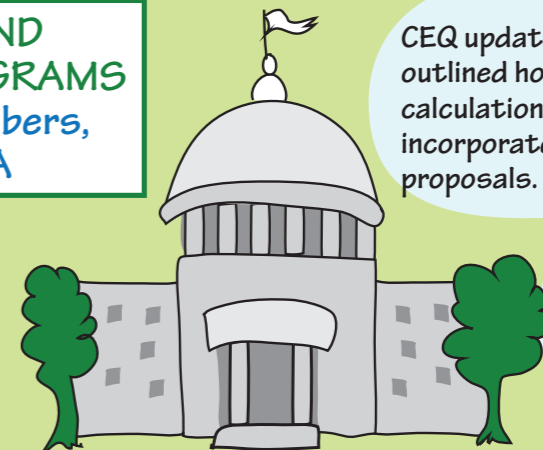

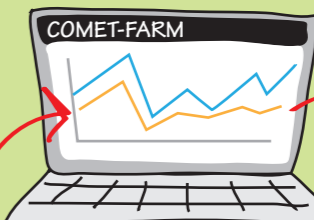
